Executive Summary

According to the Los Angeles Sanitation District, approximately 4,000 tons of food is wasted in Los Angeles County. This has dire effects on the surrounding environment as the organic material decomposes, emitting harmful greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. Unfortunately, supermarkets are a large contributor to emissions of harmful greenhouse gases into the atmosphere as they dispose of large quantities of produce and other food, such as pre-made meals, that could have otherwise been sustainably utilized. This process has significant drawbacks to achieving Sustainable Development Goal #12, which encourages admissible consumption and production patterns, and Sustainable Development Goal #13, which urges climate action.

Wasteless Solutions strives to eradicate food waste within Los Angeles County by targeting prominent Los Angeles supermarkets. With the Hispanic demographic growing to be one of the largest ethnic groups within the county, ethnic supermarkets have the opportunity to flourish. This is exemplified through one of Los Angeles' most popular Hispanic supermarkets, Gonzalaz Northgate Markets.
